

# iexec: L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X Package for Inputable Shell Executions

This package helps you execute shell commands right from the document and then put their output to the document:

```
\documentclass{article}
\usepackage{iexec}
\begin{document}
Today is \iexec{date +%e-%b-%Y}.
\end{document}
```

Today is 8-Jul-2021

You have to run `pdflatex` with the `--shell-escape` flag in order to let `ShellEscape` (the package we use) to run shell.

There are two commands: `\exec` and `\iexec`. The first one executes, while the second one also inputs the output of the execution.
