The left and right sides are put in columns. We use $\ensuremath{\mbox{\mbox{ledsectnotoc}\{L\}}\$ to say we want the right titles be added to the table of contents, and not the left titles. We also use $\ensuremath{\mbox{\mbox{\mbox{eledsectmark}\{R\}}}\$ to use the right side to add $\ensuremath{\mbox{\mbox{\mbox{\mbox{eledsectmark}\{R\}}}\ }$
