It is directed to Latin Modern fonts. It provide the following files: fd and sty. This mechanism is useful in mixed text composition. For example: Japanese–Latin.

3.1 Preamble

```
\usepackage{lmodern}
\usepackage[T1]{fontenc}
\usepackage{amsmath}
\usepackage{amssymb}
\usepackage[scale=1.09,ttscale=1.12]{variablelm}
```

Remark: amsmath is for `\big`, `\Big`, `\bigg`, etc.

3.2 Options

- `scale`: Roman, italic, bold, bold italic, small caps
- `ttscale`: fixed (`\ttfamily`)
- `sfscale`: sans-serif (`\sffamily`)
- `encoding`: font encoding (default: T1)
- `variablett`: same the lmodern.sty
- `lighttt`: same the lmodern.sty
