

NAME

m-tx – This script processes mtx files then deletes intermediate files

SYNOPSIS

[texlua] **m-tx[.lua]** { *option* | *jobname* [.mtx] } ...

The default effect is to process each file using

prepmx(1)	(pre-pre-processing pass)
pmxab(1)	(pre-processing pass)
etex(1)	(first pass)
musixflx(1)	(second pass)
etex(1)	(third pass)
dvips(1)	(dvi to Postscript)
ps2pdf(1)	(Postscript to Portable Document Format)

followed by removal of intermediate files.

OPTIONS

- v output program name and version number, and quit
- h output usage summary and quit
- l changes the TeX processor to **latex(1)** or **pdflatex(1)**
- p changes the TeX processor to **pdfetex(1)** or **pdflatex(1)** (and doesn't run **dvips(1)** and **ps2pdf(1)** or **dvipdfm(1)**)
- d changes the dvi processor to **dvipdfm(1)**
- s stops processing at the dvi file
- t stops processing at the tex (and midi) files
- m stops processing at the pmx file
- i retain intermediate files
- f default processing

Options affect processing of all succeeding mtx files unless changed by another option.
