## There Is No Largest Prime Number

The proof uses reductio ad absurdum.

## Theorem

There is no largest prime number.

## Proof.

- Suppose p were the largest prime number.
- Let q be the product of the first p numbers.
- ① Then q + 1 is not divisible by any of them
- 1 Thus q + 1 is also prime and greater than p.
