Introduction

This package takes care of configuring the two ToCs used in *Introduktion til L^AT_EX*. The package is build for this book only and does not contain much room for configuration.

Macros

`\spart` `\spart{<text>}` this inserts `<text>` into the the `.toc` file using a special `spart` style which is used in the short ToC. This does mean that `\part` entries has to be entered twice, but it also enables us to insert special features into the ToC that does not necessarily has to be present in both.

`\MakeShortToC` `\MakeShortToC` prints a short ToC displaying only yhe chapters (without chapter numbers) and the text inserted using `\spart`, the title is typeset using `\shortcontentsname`. `\MakeNormalToC` creates a sort of normal ToC, the title is typeset using `\contentsname`. Note that each subsubsection entry is typeset like a runin list, each separated by `\cftdlfsubsubseccomma`. `\preprocessToC` will preprocess the entire ToC, and calculates the indents for section and subsection entries. It should be inserted before `\MakeNormalToC`.

`\MakeNormalToC` `\ToCSubsectionIndentsPullBack` this will change the indent in the ToC for the subsubsection entries, this is very useful if one wants to have unnumbered entries under a section instead of a subsection. `\ToCSubsectionIndentsBackToNormal` sets the indentation back to normal.
