

Test accent macro name clashes

The LGR font encoding defines the \< and \> shortcuts for Greek dasia and psili accents as “TextAccent” macros (see fntguide.pdf).

While “lgrenc.def” defines them just for LGR font encoding, “textalpha.sty” makes LGR the default encoding for these accents.

This means that with \usepackage[LGR,T1]{fontenc}, the accent macros are undefined in all other font encodings and can be given another definition. However, due to the internal working of \DeclareTextAccent, earlier definitions of these macros are overwritten.

Test: macro defined before fontenc loading: *early local definition* <

Test: macro (re)defined after fontenc loading: *local default* >

Test: accent macro kept in LGR: ῥ ἐαρλψ λοσαλ δεφινιτιον ῑη

Test: accent macro overwritten also in LGR: ῥ λοσαλ δεφ αυλτ ῑη

Test: TextCommandDefault at end of group: *early local definition* <

Test: Tab accent kludge: *early local definition* <
