Preamble

This file demonstrates how `icite` can be used to produce an index of passages cited in combination with BibLATEX.

The relevant part of the preamble which is used here follows:

Remarks

- (a) `citecmd=autocite` instructs `icite` to use the `\autocite` command to insert the citations in the body text.
- (b) `defaultindex=none` disables indexing by default.
- (c) `\IndexSubtypeAs{ancient}{pr-sources}` makes an exception for authors whose `entrysubtype` field matches the string `ancient` and instructs `icite` to have them indexed in an index named `pr-sources`.
- (d) To actually produce the index, `\printindex[pr-sources]` is needed at the end of the document.

Body text

Plato, *Laches*: first citation¹. And another², and another³.

Plato, *Theaetetus*: first citation⁴. And another⁵, and another⁶.

Aristotle, *Politica*: first citation⁷. And another⁸, and another⁹.

This passage should not be indexed¹⁰.
