## Example for pagecolor

This example demonstrates the use of package pagecolor, v1.0b as of 2011/08/06 (HMM). The used option was pagecolor={LightGoldenrod1}. pagecolor={none} would be the default.

Save per page about 200 ml water,  $2\,\mathrm{g}$  CO<sub>2</sub> and  $2\,\mathrm{g}$  wood: Therefore please print only if this is really necessary.

The current page (background) colour is \thepagecolor = LightGoldenrod1 (and \thepagecolornone = LightGoldenrod1, which would only be different from \thepagecolor, when the page colour would be none). The current page (background) colour is \thepagecolor = rgb:-green!40!yellow,3;green!40!yellow,2;red,1.

Which made the preceding line of text practically invisible.
