

## Example for regstats

This example demonstrates the use of package `regstats`, v1.0d as of 2011/06/18 (HMM).

The used options were `proof=false, left=true, timer=true`.

`proof=false` is the default, but neither `left=true` nor `timer=true` are defaults (`left=false, timer=false` would be the defaults).

If  $\varepsilon$ -TeX is available with your L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X-distribution and you want to use it, uncomment the

```
%% \usepackage{etex}[1998/03/26]% v2.0
```

line in the preamble of this document.

(Also `\eTeX` instead of `$\varepsilon$-TeX` would be available with it).
