bibzbladd.pl - add Zbl numbers to papers in a given bib file

# SYNOPSIS

bibzbladd [-d] [-f] [-e 1|0] [-o output] bib\_file

### **OPTIONS**

- -d Debug mode
- -e If 1 (default), add an empty zblnumber if a zbl cannot be found. This prevents repeated searches for the same entries if you add new entries to the file. Calling −e 0 suppresses this behavior.
- -f Force searching for Zbl numbers even if the entry already has one.

#### -o output

Output file. If this option is not used, the name for the output file is formed by adding \_zbl to the input file

## DESCRIPTION

The script reads a BibTeX file. It checks whether the entries have Zbls. If not, tries to contact internet to get the numbers. The result is a BibTeX file with the fields <code>zblnumber=...</code> added.

The name of the output file is either set by the -o option or is derived by adding the suffix \_zbl to the output file.
