This manual page is not meant to be exhaustive. The complete documentation for this version of  $T_EX$  can be found in the info file or manual *Web2C: A TeX implementation*.

**eplain** is an extension of plain  $T_EX$  described in the book  $T_EX$  for troff for the Impatient. It adds these features (among others) to plain  $T_EX$ :

- left-justified displays
- double-column output
- tables of contents
- hrule and vrule with a different default than 0.4pt
- time of day
- verbatim file listing
- generalized footnotes
- blank and black boxes
- citations using BIBT<sub>E</sub>X
