sjisconv - convert a TeX document in SJIS encoding into 'preprocessed' form.

SYNOPSIS

sjisconv < *infile* > *outfile*

DESCRIPTION

SJIS encoding for Japanese uses the characters {, }, and \setminus which have special meanings in TeX documents.

After processing a $L^{AT}EX 2_{\varepsilon}$ document which contains SJIS characters with **sjisconv** you need not care about these special characters.

This filter is part of the CJK macro package for $L^{AT}EX 2_{\varepsilon}$
