sjisconv – convert a TeX document in SJIS encoding into 'preprocessed' form.

SYNOPSIS

sjisconv < *infile* > *outfile*

DESCRIPTION

SJIS encoding for Japanese uses the characters $\{, \}$, and \setminus which have special meanings in T_EX documents.

After processing a $L^{A}T_{E}X$ $2_{\mathcal{E}}$ document which contains SJIS characters with **sjisconv** you need not care about these special characters.

This filter is part of the CJK macro package for LATEX 2.
