

**NAME**

`sjisconv` – convert a TeX document in SJIS encoding into ‘preprocessed’ form.

**SYNOPSIS**

`sjisconv <infile> <outfile>`

**DESCRIPTION**

SJIS encoding for Japanese uses the characters {, }, and \ which have special meanings in T<sub>E</sub>X documents.

After processing a L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X 2<sub>ε</sub> document which contains SJIS characters with **sjisconv** you need not care about these special characters.

This filter is part of the **CJK** macro package for L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X 2<sub>ε</sub>.
