

NAME

`tex2aspc` – converts conventional MusiXTeX scores to .aspc format for processing by **autosp**(1).

SYNOPSIS

`tex2aspc [-v | --version | -h | --help]`

`tex2aspc infile[.tex] [outfile[.aspc]]`

DESCRIPTION

This program re-factors (sequences of) conventional note-spacing commands (`\notes \Notes \NOtes ...`) in a measure into a single `\anotes` command. This is intended for "legacy" scores in order to take advantage of features only provided by **autosp**(1), such as "global" skips and processing of `TransformNotes` commands.

LIMITATIONS

tex2aspc assumes that `&` and `|` (rather than `\nextinstrument` and `\nextstaff`) are used to separate instruments and staves.

User-defined macros are not processed or expanded.
