- **-f** Format output according to the format specifier *format*.
- **-V** Show version of the program and exit.
- **-h** Show summary of options.
- file Scan file recursively for font faces.

RETURN CODES

fc-scan returns error code 0 if at least one font was found or 1 otherwise.
