1 Introduction

The soul package provides the \hl command for highlighting text; unfortunately this packages does not work in right to left documents.

The bidihl package allows users to highlight text in both right to left and left to right directions; it needs the bidi package and should always be loaded before bidi package.

2 Basic usage

\bidihl $\{\langle text \rangle\}$

Highlights the text. The default highlighting box color is yellow; if a different color is desired, then simply define a new color with bidihlcolor as the name of the color; i.e.

\definecolor{bidihlcolor}{rgb}{0.3,0.1,0}

The default highlighting box height is 10pt; again if a different height is desired, then change the length of \bidihlboxheight; i.e.

\setlength{\bidihlboxheight}{8pt}

The height of the highlighting box does not automatically change; you have to set its length manually.
