This manual page is not meant to be exhaustive. The complete documentation for this version of TeX can be found in the info file or manual *Web2C: A TeX implementation*.

eplain is an extension of plain TeX described in the book *TeX for troff for the Impatient*. It adds these features (among others) to plain TeX:

- left-justified displays
- double-column output
- tables of contents
- `\hrule` and `\vrule` with a different default than 0.4pt
- time of day
- verbatim file listing
- generalized footnotes
- blank and black boxes
- citations using BIBTeX
