**pslatex** [*LATEXARGS*] *LATEXFILE*[.tex]

**DESCRIPTION**

**pslatex** allows you to typeset a LaTeX source file using basic Adobe Type 1 PostScript fonts (Times, Helvetica, and Courier) *without* editing the file to load the necessary packages.

It takes any arguments that **latex**(1) can take.
