DESCRIPTION

SJIS encoding for Japanese uses the characters {, }, and \ which have special meanings in TEX documents.

After processing a \LaTeX 2 $_{\mathcal{E}}$ document which contains SJIS characters with **sjisconv** you need not care about these special characters.
